BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION

Everyone has been busy since the first joint meeting on January 21, 2025! From planning for the Cleveland Avenue project to coordinating community-wide events and managing day-to-day operations, the Chamber, Main Street, and the Town have continued working collaboratively on behalf of Wellington and the region.

This upcoming meeting will include updates on several topics discussed at the January 21 meeting, an overview of new activities and initiatives, and an update on the Cleveland Avenue project.

Several new projects are progressing or are in development including the Walk of Fame and the workforce development/job board page. These initiatives will be presented to ensure all partners are informed and aligned.

Town staff will provide the latest updates on the Cleveland Avenue project. In addition, the C3 group has been actively developing strategies to support local businesses during construction, drawing on lessons learned from other municipalities with similar projects.

We look forward to continuing our strong collaboration as we move forward on these important initiatives for Wellington.

We are pleased to share a brief update on the Downtown Wellington Shop Local Marketing Campaign, made possible by a \$25,000 grant provided to the Wellington Main Street Program from the Department of Local Affairs (DOLA) for being an "Exceptional Level" community under the State's Main Street Program.

Selected Firm:

We selected Slate Communications to lead the campaign. They are also producing the new community video for Wellington, allowing for cohesive storytelling and branding across platforms.

Campaign Objectives:

The campaign aims to increase visibility and support for downtown businesses and the community through strategic marketing that highlights the value of shopping locally and fosters community connections.

Progress to Date:

- Developed a comprehensive marketing plan
- Selected "Find Your Place in Wellington" as the official campaign slogan
- Created graphics for social media, advertisements, and print posters
- Provided advertising recommendations for both digital and print channels
- Captured photos and video content during the St. Paddy's Day celebration
- Completed the first draft of the story board for the community video
- Selected business directory style and content

Next Steps:

- Complete videography for community video
- Conduct photo and video shoots with all remaining Main Street businesses
- Host a Marketing 101 session for businesses and provide local business media kit
- Develop online business directory
- Create templates for post card mailer, print media ads, and pole banners
- Identify additional promotional strategies to expand the campaign and encourage the community to get involved.

All deliverables are on track for completion by June 25, 2025, in compliance with the DOLA grant timeline. Included below are examples of the selected logo and current template graphics developed for the campaign.


