#### **BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION**

The annual review of the fee schedule is an integral step in the budget development process to ensure costs are recovered for services provided by the Town and to forecast revenues for the fiscal year.

Recommended changes to take effect January 1, 2026, are as follows:

- Annual Vendor Fee Removed as it is already covered with Business License fees, per Town code
- Additional information included in **SPECIAL EVENTS** regarding Business License and Liquor License fees, for convenience
- Snow Removal Changed for clarity, but no increase
- Nuisance Abatement Changed from 10% to 5% per State statute (Town code states 10%)
- **CORA Request**s Updated to "maximum allowed by State statute", which is the practice of the Town, reducing the potential for error if the State changes fee
- Notary Removed, provided as a service to the community
- Code Sections and clarifications added to **BUSINESS LICENSES**
- **Peddler's and Handbill License** Removed monthly and quarterly fees, updated annual based on comparisons with other Northern Colorado municipalities
- Pawnbrokers and Secondhand Dealers Added since it is referenced in Town code but was missing from the fee schedule
- Liquor License— Most common fees removed and updated to "maximum allowed by State liquor laws", which is the practice of the Town, reducing the potential for errors if State changes fees
  - o Remaining fees listed are assessed outside the State laws or fees that the State allows to be charged and must be noted in the Town's fee schedule
- **Demolition** / **Mitigation** Change in title only. Added mitigation to this permit type for smoke/water damage or other contaminants that need mitigation prior to a remodel permit. The procedures and inspections are most closely in alignment with demolitions.
- IMPACT & CAPITAL INVESTMENT page is not reviewed as part of this review as they are included in the municipal utility rates and fees update being presented in the near future

#### 2026 Personnel and Benefits

#### Merit/COLA:

2026 Proposed 3% merit/COLA Pool

2025: 5% pool

2024: 6% pool

2023: 5.5% pool

#### **Market Considerations:**

<u>Local Municipalities:</u> While there remains some uncertainty, current discussions indicate COLA/merit increases between 3% and 5% for 2026.

<u>National Trends:</u> According to a 2025 study by WTW, published by SHRM, the average salary increase budget for U.S. companies in 2026 is projected at 3.5%.

<u>Compensation Planning:</u> The Town conducts a compensation study every two years to ensure staff are paid competitively compared to the market. The most recent study was conducted in 2024, and the next study is anticipated in 2026, to inform 2027 wages. Maintaining a 3% merit/COLA pool for 2026 helps ensure our pay remains aligned with market expectations and supports the Town's efforts to attract and retain qualified staff.

#### **Health Insurance:**

The Town of Wellington is entering its fifth year utilizing the Colorado Employers Benefit Trust (CEBT) for health insurance benefits. CEBT is a multiple employer trust serving the public sector in Colorado. For the second consecutive year, CEBT has announced a 13.5% premium increase for all small group health plans.

2022: Town joined CEBT

2023: 4.5% increase

2024: 5% increase

2025: 13.5% increase

2026: 13.5% increase

Over the past decade, CEBT premium increases have ranged from 2% to 13.5% with an average annual increase of 5.9%.



Due to the significant cost increase in 2026, the Town cannot fully absorb the additional expense. To determine the most appropriate cost-sharing approach, staff were polled regarding their preferred method of offsetting rising premiums. Seventy-eight percent of staff who participated in the poll preferred to drop down a tier of coverage to help offset some monthly costs.

In response, the Town will drop one tier in health care plans and will increase the employee premium to help offset the additional expense.

While CEBT has provided reliable coverage since 2022, the Town plans to explore other health insurance options after 2026 to ensure continued affordability and value for employees and the organization.

#### **BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION**

The following is the first draft of the Town of Wellington operating expenditures for fiscal year 2026. Operating expenditure requests, in total, are \$17.6 million, a decrease of 4.3% from the operating expenditures budget for fiscal year 2025.

The budget priorities identified by the Board at the May 20, 2025, Work Session are highlighted first. Staff sought estimates for related expenditures and included them in the operating expenditures that follow. Of note:

Economic Development: \$35,000Emergency Preparedness: \$40,000

• Home Rule: \$110,000

The operating expenditures draft contains actual expenditures for fiscal year 2024, the budget for fiscal year 2025, actual expenditures year-to-date through June 30, 2025, estimated end of fiscal year 2025 expenditures, and the requested budget for fiscal year 2026. Although the Town's fund structure and budget appropriations are typically separated into General Fund, Street Fund, Water Fund, Sewer Fund, Drainage Fund, and Park Fund, for the purpose of this first draft, all expenditures are separated by department. This format allows for a comparison and review of past trends, current expectations, and future projections.

Revenues and fund balances are not included in the first draft. Finance Staff is reviewing sales tax trends, property tax assessments, fee schedule, building permits, and other revenue projections at this time. Guidance from the Board on operating expenditures, and in the weeks to come, capital improvement projects, will have a direct impact on the projected fund balances. Town Staff will continue to refine budget requests and projections prior to presenting the Board with the complete draft budget. As required by Town code, Sec. 4-3-10, the Town Administrator shall submit the annual budget no later than the first regular meeting in October of each year.

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff is seeking input on the requests in the first draft of the Town's operating expenditures for fiscal year 2026. The current requests reflect a conservative approach, and further feedback from both the Board of Trustees is essential to guide decision-making moving forward.
